Terms and Conditions of the Agreement

- 1 This Show is conducted by the Kilcoy P A and I Society subject to the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (QCAS), and the constitution and rules of the Society. In any conflict between the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the constitution and rules of the Society, the constitution and rules of the Society shall prevail.
- 2 The Society reserves the right to refuse entry to any entertainer if the Society reasonably believes that it is necessary to do so to ensure that the standard, quality and safety of the Show is maintained.
- 3 The President, or any member of the Management Committee shall have the right to alter or amend the programme, or the time of any event or performance.
- 4 The Society will not under any circumstances hold itself liable for any accident, loss, damage or non-delivery of any goods, and it shall be a condition of entry to the Show that each entertainer shall hold the Society blameless and indemnify it against any claim, demand or legal proceeding arising through any accident, loss, damage or non-delivery.
- 5 Entertainers must follow any lawful instruction of the President or any member of the Management Committee.
- 6 The President shall have the right to evict from the grounds any person who behaves in an offensive or improper manner.

Alcohol and Drug Policy

The Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies considers that any entertainer who is affected by alcohol or drugs while performing at the Show is exhibiting an unacceptable form of behaviour. The Chamber has a zero-tolerance policy in such cases.

Disciplinary action (which may include a warning, dismissal from performing or referral to authorities) may be taken against any performer who is, in the view of the Society, affected by alcohol or drugs.

Indemnity

- 2 I agree not to make any claim against the Society for any injury or loss sustained by me at the show.
- 3 I agree to indemnify, and to keep indemnified, the Society (including its members, agents and employees) against all claims, demands, actions, costs (including legal costs), charges, expenses, damages, loss or other liability in connection with property loss or damage (including property of the Society) or personal injury or death arising out of, or in connection with the performances.
- 4 I acknowledge that no insurance is provided on my behalf and that I am responsible for arranging my own public liability and all other insurances.
