Mud Pies must be delivered to the Kilcoy Showgrounds Exhibit Pavilion on Friday 8th May or no later than 8 am on Saturday 9th May 2020.

Judging will commence at 8:30 am sharp on Saturday morning.

Judging and writing up of the place cards may take a couple of hours to do as this cannot be pre-done. (Take the kiddies around to check out the great Kilcoy Show while this is being done)

All entries must have the child's (Cook/Bakers) name, age and class entered to allow names to be correctly written on the placecards.
